In 1986, four friends from Kenilworth, who travelled regularly to Coventry for their swimming sessions, took advantage of the newly opened Abbey Fields indoor pool to set up a new club - the Kenilworth Over 40 swimming club - founder member Harry Langley said "there has only been one change in the last 30-odd years - the ladies were not keen to admit to being over 40 so we changed the name to Over 30 Swimming Club - that did the trick!"



Membership was oversubscribed with a limit of 48 members on the books, but in reality, no more than 24 swimmers were there every Sunday morning at 8:00 am. We had a waiting list!

Over the years, we have engaged in many fund raising activities, the most obvious was the annual swimathon, where we raised over £2,000

for the local Myton Hospice, over £1,000 for Bethany's Wish



charity and a good time was had by all.

All this, together with social events to generate funds for the club, meant we were a healthy bunch and although membership numbers have dropped recently, the "younger" members undertook open water swimming challenges (River Dart 10K challenge 2018, raising over £2,000) and . . .

The ultimate challenge - swim the English Channel - a relay swim where three of our members formed a team made up of five like minded lunatics, swam the Channel in 15 hours and raised well over £11,000 for the Aspire charity in 2020.
